

CTE TWO-FOR-ONE EQUIVALENCY CREDIT GRADUATION REQUIREMENT WAIVER REQUEST

The “two-for-one” policy for Career and Technical Education (CTE) courses is a rule change in effect for students in the graduating class of 2016 and beyond. Students who take CTE-equivalent courses may satisfy two graduation requirements while earning one credit for a single course. The purpose of this policy is to create flexibility for students to choose more elective courses or to address other graduation requirements. (WAC 180-51-067)

The new policy will permit a second graduation requirement to be “checked off” as “met” by the school counseling program. The course is put on the transcript and the student determines which two graduation requirements are met based on their high school and beyond plan.
