

SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION Rev 5/16/17

Programs Offered:

- **SUPER SENIORS ONLY:** Offered via **GRAD POINT**, this program is for Bellingham Public School seniors who did not graduate with their 2017 Cohort. This program is free.
- **COE:** (Collection of Evidence) **COE:** (Collection of Evidence) Geared for students who have taken some form of a state tests and not met standards, i.e., Smarter Balanced ELA or math; EOC Math (Algebra or Geometry) and Bio and or HSPE. This program is free. This course provides content area instruction and support for students as they create a collection of performance tasks used as an alternative state assessment for high school graduation. COEs started in Summer School can be continued in fall at student's home high school. COE's will be submitted to the state in January 2018.
- **Credit Retrieval via GRAD POINT for 10-12 graders entering Fall of 2017:** Payment is on sliding fee scale. See attached registration form for courses that will be offered.
- **Credit Ahead via GRAD POINT for 10-12 graders entering Fall of 2017:** See attached registration form for courses that will be offered. Full pay at \$185.
- **Health CREDIT AHEAD via MOODLE :** Available for students who will be in grades 9-12 in Fall of 2017. Full pay at \$185. Use BVL 2017 Summer School form on district website to apply.
- **BVL:** "Stand Alone" courses not offered through BPS Summer School Program can be taken via BVL. Available only for BPS students who will be in grades 10-12 in Fall of 2017. By counselor permission. Full pay at \$185. Use BVL 2017 Summer School form on district website to apply.

Other Details

- All students wishing to enroll must complete the registration form completed with their high school counselor by June 23rd, 2017. Walk-in registration is also available June 26th at BHS. Registrations completed by June 23rd will be given course priority. Students may only take one course. Super Seniors are the exception to this.
- All summer school programs held at BHS from June 26-August 3rd; Monday through Thursday. Sessions run 8:30-10:00; 10:30-12:00. Students can confirm their course and session by using Skyward user name and password.
- Daily attendance is required for Credit Retrieval/Credit Ahead, Super Seniors and COE!
- Moodle Health: Students are required to attend an orientation session and 'hands-on' CPR training session on June 26th in the BHS library from 9:00am-10:30am.
- Families can pay summer school fees any time at their home high school or on the first day when classes begin (June 26th). Registrations will not be accepted until money has been deposited by ASB bookkeeper.
- Students can work at their own pace for course completion. COE work not completed by August 3rd can be completed by students in fall at home high school.
- Gradpoint is a computer based curriculum supported by highly qualified teachers during summer school.
- Moodle Health and BVL are online programs supported remotely by highly qualified online teachers.

Student Expectations

- Attendance: Students are expected to attend every day. Two tardies will be considered as one absence and a maximum of two excused absences will be allowed. Truancies may result in removal from the program with no refund. Parents/guardians will be called to verify all absences. Students need to communicate about their absences with their teachers.
- Behavior: Students shall meet all school district expectations, rules, and guidelines. Please refer to BPS Policy #3200.
- Grades: will be reported at the end of summer school to families and students' home high school in August 2017.
