

## GENERAL SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION Rev 5/3/19

### Programs Offered:

- **SUPER SENIORS ONLY:** Offered via **GRAD POINT**, this program is for Bellingham Public Schools seniors who did not graduate with their 2019 Cohort. This program is free.
- **COE ELA and COE Math:** The Collection of Evidence (COE) for English Language Arts or math is for students who have taken the Smarter Balanced state test and not met the standard required for graduation. Students will receive content instruction and support as they create a collection of performance tasks to demonstrate proficiency needed for high school graduation. Earning course credit (.25) and meeting the collection's minimum score is required to satisfy the high school graduation requirement. This program is free.
- **GRAD POINT Credit Ahead for 10-12 graders entering Fall of 2019:** See attached registration form for courses that will be offered. Full pay at \$185.
- **GRAD POINT Credit Retrieval for 10-12 graders entering Fall of 2019:** See attached registration form for courses that will be offered. Payment is on sliding fee scale.
- **Health CREDIT AHEAD via MOODLE :** Available for students who will be in grades 9-12 in Fall of 2019. Full pay at \$185. Use BVL 2019 Summer School form on district website to apply.
- **BVL:** "Stand Alone" courses not offered through BPS Summer School Program can be taken via BVL. Available only for BPS students who will be in grades 10-12 in Fall of 2019. By counselor permission. Full pay at \$185. Use BVL 2019 Summer School form on district website to apply.

### Other Details

- To enroll in summer school, students must complete the registration form with their high school counselor by June 19, 2019. Walk-in registration is also available June 24 at OHS. Registrations completed by June 19 will be given course priority. Students may only take one course. Super Seniors are the exception to this.
- Courses in Grad Point, COE's and Super Seniors will be held at OHS from June 24-August 1; Monday through Thursday. Sessions run 8:30-10 a.m.; 10:30 a.m.-12 p.m. Daily attendance is required.
- Students can confirm their course and session by using Skyward user name and password.
- Moodle Health: Students are required to attend an orientation session and 'hands-on' CPR training session on June 24 from 9-10:30 a.m. in Room 129 at BHS.
- Families can pay summer school fees any time at their home high school or on the first day when classes begin (June 24). Registrations will not be accepted until money has been deposited by ASB bookkeeper.
- Students can work at their own pace for course completion.
- Grad Point is a computer based curriculum supported by highly qualified teachers during summer school.
- Moodle Health and BVL are online programs supported remotely by highly qualified online teachers. There is no daily attendance requirement for Moodle Health or BVL classes.

### Grad Point, COE and Super Senior Summer School Expectations:

- Attendance: Students enrolled in summer school classes are expected to attend every day. Truancies may result in removal from the program with no refund. Parents/guardians will be called to verify all absences. Students need to communicate about their absences with their teachers.
- Students who miss a session(s) for vacations, illness, etc., are expected to make up the session.
- Behavior: Students shall meet all school district expectations, rules, and guidelines. Please refer to BPS Policy #3200.
- Grades: will be reported at the end of summer school to families and students' home high school in August 2019.
