District Technology Plan Steering Committee made a decision on a strategy at their first meeting this year (October 10, 2010)

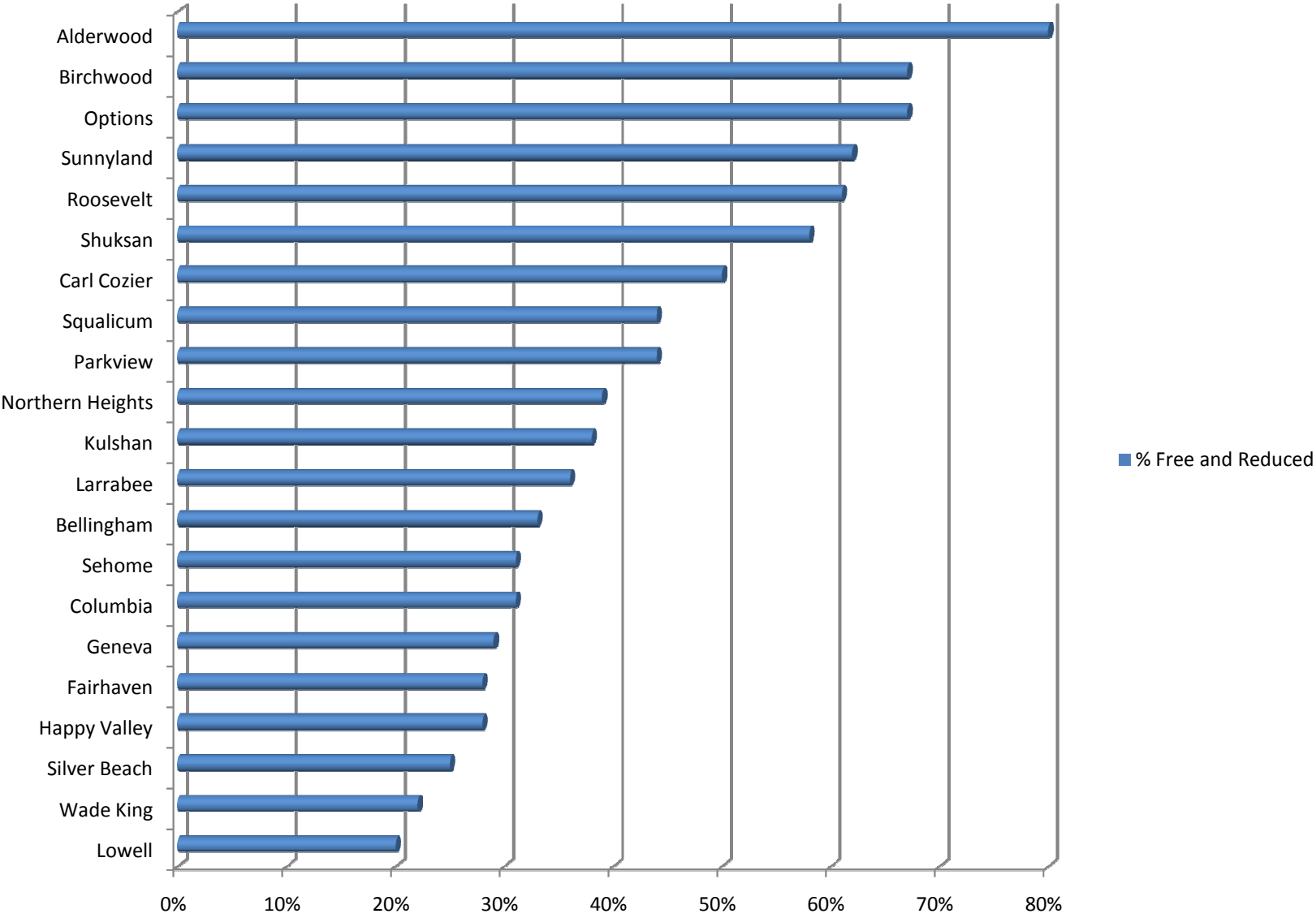
- Decision:

Allocate to schools based on the combined number of students participating in the Free & Reduced Lunch Program and the number of students classified as English Language Learners.

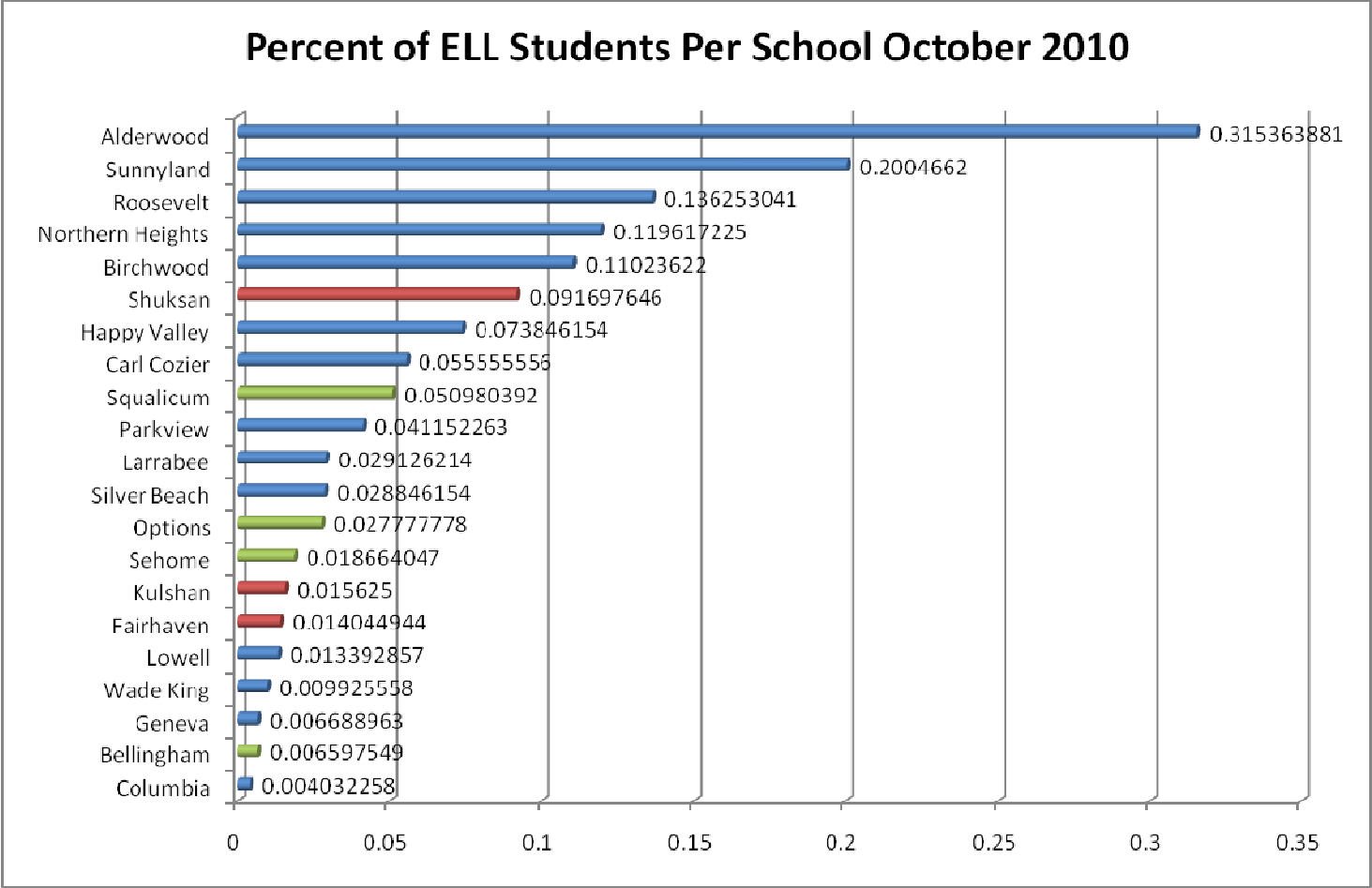
# Committee's reason for strategy
