1. Student Information Systems-Jim

An update on the current status of Zangle was given by John Getchell. Zangle has ceased to provide online product support, but apparently another SIS company is considering assuming product support services. A dialogue about a potential switch from Zangle to a more recent/popular SIS ensued. Based on the complexity and consequences of such a transition, John stated that if the district was to consider transitioning, it would need to be vetted through a process similar to the instructional materials adoption procedure.
