The Board on the date shown above received and reviewed the official internal monitoring report of its policy E-1 submitted by the Superintendent. Following its review of the report, the Board concludes:


1. Based upon the information provided, the Board finds that the Superintendent HAS *reasonably interpreted* all the provisions of the relevant Ends policy.
2. Based upon the information provided, the Board finds that the Superintendent's report and other information provided DO *provide sufficient evidence* to determine the District's progress in achieving the established goals of the policy.
3. Based upon the information provided, the Board finds that the district HAS achieved the goals established in the policy.

Additional Comments:

- *Every facet of the Walking in the Shoes project is on point. I have heard wonderful comments from the community about this as well. Good job!*
- *E-1 speaks to every child and a collective community commitment. My two big take-aways from the mission and vision are 1) every child has individualized instruction and support to meet his/her needs; and 2) the district is increasingly working with community partners to support our children. Neither of these is addressed in the report.*
- *The administration has made The Bellingham Promise come alive, by presenting it district-wide in a consistent format and by tying it into the work at all levels.*
- *Should we consider asking for ways the vision and mission are translated into action? That is, provide examples of how the district supports its staff to empower students to discover and develop a passion and to contribute to the community.*
- *The policy should be revised to clear up differences in interpretation.*
