1. Parent representative Rachel Williams, who served on the Calendar Committee last year, and student representative Lauren Gibb joined the committee for this year's work.
2. The committee considered the time feedback from the Labor Management team and further discussed the uncertainty of implementing the new Washington state law requiring 1,080 hours of instructional time for students in grades 7-12, and the uncertainty of the impact of the upcoming Collective Bargaining Agreement for 2014-15.
3. After considering several calendar options, the committee made the decision to submit a draft school calendar for 2014-15 with a specific start date, holidays and an open-ended end date, to staff and families the first week of January.
4. The next meeting will be Wednesday, Jan. 22, and we will review the input from the survey and hope to make adjustments to the calendar and submit the final recommendation to Dr. Baker and the BEA membership.
