Dr. Baker shared an update regarding our new Promise Kindergarten Program.

Defining High Quality Preschools: We worked through continued definition of *High Quality Preschool*. Details were captured on the document, *Defining High Quality Preschools, BPS PreK Advisory Review Team, draft 2-13-14*. Revisions to the document will be made and brought back to the next meeting.

Identifying Drivers & Barriers

Teams created driver and barrier charts. The charts included “Current Reality” and “Desired State”, as well as things that are helping to get to the desired (drivers) and things that are getting in the way of the desired (barriers). Charts will be typed up and used for an activity at the next meeting. Sroups creating charts included:

- Flexible program options that include appropriate support staff, staff, materials, space, etc.
- Add OT, PT, SLP, nursing staffing levels to adequately and appropriately meet the needs of our students
- Finance to support the changes that can best serve all children
- If only we had appropriate spaces (inside and outside) for our existing kids and k placement options
