3:10-3:30	<p><b>Fundraising Brainstorm</b></p> <p><b>From Procedure 3440:</b> <b>The food we serve students in our school meal programs, in classroom celebrations, sold in school or during fundraisers reflects our values.</b></p> <p>Food served, sold, or marketed at school meet our food values. These values govern:</p> <p>3. Food and beverages sold to students during the extended school day must meet or exceed the <a href="#">USDA Smart Snacks in School</a> nutrition standards. This includes but is not limited to vending machines, school stores, snack or food carts.</p> <p>4. Fundraising efforts. Fundraising efforts during school hours may sell only non-food items or only foods and beverages that meet or exceed the <a href="#">USDA Smart Snacks in School</a> nutrition standards.</p> <p>5.
