Co-Chair Ron Cowan, Executive Director, Capital Projects School Facilities thanked the group for their work and believes this is just what we need to go forward with a facility design.

We will begin to hire a design team to take our ideas and come back with a design in time for this group to respond. An aggressive timeline would be to start on some of the infrastructure this summer and have the facility up and running by fall of 2019.
