* Two-story building				
* Approximately 55,000 gross square feet				
* 975 Square Foot Kindergarten Classrooms (with sink; no toilet room)				
* 950 Square Foot Grade 1-5 Classrooms (with sink; no toilet room)				
* 1,025 Square Foot Pre-K Classrooms (with sink and toilet room)				
* Extended Learning Areas Adjacent To Classrooms (small group pull out area)				
* Full Size Gymnasium (6,500 SF)				
* Wood Gymnasium Floor				
* Mix of carpet and resilient flooring for classroom flooring (consider breakfast in the classroom)				
* Polished concrete for corridor flooring				
* Displacement ventilation				
* Vinyl tackable wall covering in classrooms and hallways				
* Combination Music Classroom/Stage (Adjacent To Cafeteria and Gymnasium)				
* Separation of bus and non-bus traffic				
* Sustainable Design Elements (WSSP)				
* Provision for Portables and/or Additional Classrooms (2)
