Thanks to the passage of the Bellingham Public Schools' facilities bond in 2013, Parkview Elementary will be getting a new school gym or cafeteria, along with other building and/or site improvements if funds allow.

We are sending this as a follow-up to the letter superintendent Greg Baker sent last week. We want to let you know that the Parkview Design Advisory Committee and the project's architects have met three times to work on designs for the project. We met with Parkview staff to hear and gather their ideas, as well.

The group is excited to share its initial work with Parkview families and neighbors and receive your feedback. You are invited to a meeting from 7 – 8 p.m. on Wednesday, Jan. 7 in Parkview's cafeteria.

The projects' architects and the advisory group (which includes Parkview and school district staff, Parkview parents, principal Mylo Allen and Cornwall Park neighborhood representative John McGarrity) will be sharing our preferred design concept addressing building location, size and scope.
