### Con Comments:

Intersections – Can school zone be 3 blocks out?  
Helipad at the hospital – noise, safety  
Mitigate potential crash impact  
Traffic flow is an issue – keep it moving. Focus on safe walking and biking to school  
Open ditches – don't like those

### General Comments:

Open space  
Additional parking overall  
Make it easy to find your way around  
Create a traffic drive thru to keep traffic moving  
Traffic is huge – can we partner w/the City to make offsite improvements?  
Build space for more art  
Make sure it fits in the neighborhood – not a tall, all glass structure  
Coziness  
Stone, natural materials vs. steel



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Landscaping to match neighborhood  
School should blend into the neighborhood  
Is there a way to consider the scale so the two-story is not so looming?  
Many windows  
Entry to be large, inviting and yet maintain security  
A way to incorporate some sort of "nod" to the former building  
Include trees as much as possible  
Classrooms having a view of the park  
Use a vault for stormwater rather than pond  
Operable "garage doors" bring the outside in, create an open feel  
Solar panels  
Natural light  
Bring drop-off areas close together  
Provide short-term parking for parents to bring their kids into school  
Good ventilation  
Alternatives to fluorescent lighting
