Washington State law requires all coaches of youth sports be trained and educated about head injuries, concussions and sudden cardiac arrest. It also requires that parents and athletes receive information about head injuries and the possible consequences if an athlete returns to practice or competition too soon after a head injury and information about sudden cardiac arrest.

A signed original compliance statement is required to be on file prior to any use of a Bellingham Public Schools facility for any non-profit youth sports group. Failure to do so will result in your group's inability to use district facilities for practices and competitions.
