A Message from Principal Mylo Allen

Parkview families,

This spring, the school will be preparing for our upcoming construction project. Initially, we thought we would break ground in the month of May. However, as you may know, our design has been modified to include the repurposing of our current gym into a multipurpose space. Ultimately, the design modification has shifted our timeline so that we will now be breaking ground on the new school once students leave for summer break in June.

The silver lining is that our playground and bus loop will remain in full operation for the duration of this school year. We will also have flexibility on when and how we pack up the school garden for its eventual move.

The shift in timeline should not impact our opening date. **We are still on track to open fall 2021.**

As we near the end of this school year, I will send out detailed communications on changes we will be making during construction. Next year, most things will look similar around school, but we will be making changes to our pick-up and drop-off routine as well as our recess and lunch schedule.

Lastly, please be aware that we will be doing work to the front of our school over spring break. We will be making some modifications to the parking area to improve the flow of traffic.
