



Meeting Minutes #6
Sunnyland Elementary School
Ed Spec/Design Advisory Committee
Wednesday, February 19, 2020

Amy Berreth, Sunnyland principal, welcomed the committee together. Minutes from meeting 5 were reviewed and approved.

Dykeman architect Zach Ham introduced an adjusted meeting schedule. He then shared a brief presentation of the following concepts to facilitate thinking and discussion:

- Outdoor education and connection to outdoor spaces and nature
- Daylighting
- Collaborative learning
- Flexible classrooms
- Shared spaces/extended learning areas
- Healthy eating (nutrition)
- Makers spaces

Zach presented two committee activities. Dividing the team into three groups, the first activity called for each group to come up with their top five characteristics, qualities and attributes for the new Sunnyland Elementary School, along with five characteristics, qualities and attributes for the site. A spokesperson for each group shared with the larger group their thoughts.

In the second exercise, Zach asked the committee to envision what their ideal teaching and learning environment might look like. The three teams recorded their ideas on paper, using pictures, words and drawings.

Zach then led a final discussion with the committee of the draft numeric plan, reviewing and adjusting some program spaces, staying within the square foot target goal number of 58,000 square feet.

The next meeting will take place from 3-5 p.m., Wednesday, March 4 in the Sunnyland library.
