

1st Grade Distance Learning Essential Standards

These standards represent the critical literacy and mathematics standards selected for focus during distance learning. Additionally, standards in social emotional, science, the arts, social studies, listening, and speaking were integrated into the learning.

Reading-Literature

- Retell stories, including key details, and demonstrate understanding of main message, lesson or moral.
- Describe characters, settings, and major events in a story, using key details.
- Identify who is telling the story at various points in a story.

Reading- Informational

- Identify the main topic and retell key details of the text.
- Know and use various text features (e.g. headings, tables of contents, glossaries, electronic menus, icons) to locate key facts and information in a text.

Writing

- Write opinion pieces with a topic, a reason, and conclusion.
- Write informative/explanatory texts with a topic, some facts, and conclusions.
- Write narratives with two or more sequenced events and an ending.

Phonemic Awareness & Phonics

- Demonstrate understanding of spoken words, syllables, and sounds.
- Distinguish long from short vowel in spoken single syllable words.
- Know and apply grade level phonics in reading words.
- Know final -e and common vowel teams for long vowel sounds.

Math

- Represent and solve problems involving addition and subtraction.
- Understand and apply properties of operations and the relationship between addition and subtraction.
- Add and subtract within 20; **fluent within 10**.
- Work with addition and subtraction equations.
- Use place value understanding and properties of operations to add and subtract.
