

Policy Type: Board/Superintendent Relationship

Delegation to the Superintendent

B/SR-2

The Board's oversight of the Superintendent is through written policies that prescribe the District's ends to be achieved and describe the limitations the Superintendent may not violate. The Superintendent is allowed to use a reasonable interpretation of the written policies.

Accordingly:

1. The Board will develop policies prescribing the results the Superintendent is expected to achieve, which are referred to as the Ends Policies.
2. The Board will develop policies describing the limitations the Superintendent may exercise in achieving the Ends policies, which are referred to as the Executive Limitations Policies.
3. As long as the Superintendent uses a reasonable interpretation of the Executive Limitations policies, the Superintendent is authorized, within the confines of applicable statutes and regulations, to establish operational policies, make decisions, take actions, establish practices, and develop activities they deem appropriate to achieve the Ends policies.
4. The Board may change its Ends and Executive Limitations policies at any time, thereby changing the District's goals or the latitude of decisions given to the Superintendent. However, the Board will respect and support any reasonable interpretation of its policies.




