Welcome and group agreements

Charisse welcomed the task force members back and reminded us that we paused the task force following the April 26 meeting to wait for the OSPI review of the Washington state lessons of the 3Rs curriculum to be completed. That review was completed and published in the summer of 2022. We sent the link to the [Washington 3Rs lessons](#) to task force members to review ahead of this meeting. Most lessons are identical to the [national version of the 3Rs curriculum](#).

Christine summarized the remaining steps for the task force. These include:

- To review new Washington aligned 3Rs lessons in grade bands.
- To identify key lessons that will be expected to be taught at all schools.
- Develop and provide the professional development schedule, and support for teachers in implementing the new curriculum (this will be done by a subgroup of the CSHE task force).
- To work with high school level administration to identify a second opportunity to teach CSHE in high school.
- To present to the Instructional Materials Committee and submit a formal recommendation to Dr. Baker.

3Rs curriculum update

Elementary, middle, and high school groups convened to review the lessons and make recommendations for the specific lessons to be required and in which order they should be taught.

Christine reflected that the group reached consensus that the Washington version of the 3Rs is the curriculum that the task force will recommend for all three levels.

Each level submitted their list of lessons to be required for high school, middle school and elementary. We will develop and share documents of each grade band with lesson summaries. Charisse will submit the recommendation for adoption proposal to the Instructional Materials Committee (IMC) and to Dr. Baker following IMC.

Charisse and Christine expressed appreciation for the Task Force members, and we closed the meeting at 5:45.
